

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY No. 419

IMPLEMENTATION FALL 2006

INTERNET USE

The Board supports opportunities for students, teachers and staff members to access, evaluate, and produce information through acceptable use of the internet in the pursuit of student learning and teacher and staff professional development.

PROCEDURES

1. Schools are responsible for developing acceptable use practices and procedures to guide the use of the internet in accordance with Prairie Spirit School Division's *Acceptable Use Guidelines*.
2. The practices and procedures are to include, but are not limited to the following:
 - a. Statement of purpose for the use of internet in instruction
 - b. Supervision of computers where internet access is available
 - c. Definition of acceptable use of the internet
 - d. Consequences to persons who misuse access privileges
 - e. Control of printing from the internet
 - f. Copyright compliance and,
 - g. Accessibility for staff and students.
3. Email accounts are to be provided to designated staff only, and are to be considered the property of the school division with right of access by appropriate supervisors.
4. Schools shall communicate their acceptable use policy to their communities.
