

Driver Education Spring and Summer Classes

Appendix B AP-609 Driver Education

It is preferable for students to complete their driver education during the school year because this offers students the experience of driving in a variety of conditions and gives them more time to practice.

Additional spring/summer courses may be made available at a designated Prairie Spirit location for eligible students, provided there is a minimum of twenty (20) students requesting the additional course. This is a discretionary option of the Division and not a requirement. Whenever possible, students will take driver education during the school year and at their home school. Eligibility for spring/summer classes will be based on the criteria outlined below:

Students must meet the eligibility criteria as identified in Appendix A - Driver Education –
 Student Eligibility Guidelines.

Note: For summer classes, students must be fifteen (15) years old by the start date of the course (this is different than the fourteen (14) years nine (9) months used during the school year).

- It is the responsibility of the parents/caregivers to provide transportation to the location where driver education is being offered.
- Students must register for summer classes by April 30.
- The Coordinator for driver education will review all the applications for summer courses and determine the qualifying students based on age priority and previous opportunities for completion.
- The Coordinator or designate will contact the families of qualifying students by June 15.
- A refundable deposit of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) will be collected from each qualifying student and will be refunded once the student has completed the course.
