STUDENT BEHAVIOUR ON SCHOOL BUSES	

Purpose: To ensure that student behaviour on school buses is consistent with that expected of the student in the classroom as outlined in AP-409 Student Behaviour.

Procedure

- 1) Posting of Rules
 - a) Bus rules specific to travelling on a school bus are to be posted by the driver in each bus.
 - b) “Busing Guidelines for Families” will be provided at the beginning of the school year to each family.
 - c) Rules are to be developed by the Transportation Manager.
- 2) Failing to Abide by Rules
 - a) A student who fails to abide by the rules or who misbehaves on a bus may be denied bus transportation.
 - b) Subsequent to consultation with the driver, the principal may suspend a student from riding the bus. The first day of the suspension is to be the school day following the day the student and parent/guardian are informed of the suspension by the principal.
 - c) The principal is to immediately inform the Transportation Manager of the action taken and the reason for the suspension.
 - d) The principal is also to inform the Deputy Director or designate.
 - e) In the event that the principal recommends a suspension exceeding three (3) days, the Deputy Director or designate will decide on appropriate action to be taken in accordance with AP-409 Student Discipline.
