Purpose:

The Board is comprised of Trustees elected to represent the eight (8) rural subdivisions, two (2) urban subdivisions, and one (1) First Nation. To that end, the Board and Trustees have a duty of accountability to the communities they serve in the best interest of students and the overall Division.

Policy:

- 1) Make decisions that reflect Prairie Spirit's strategic plan and commitments and that represent the interests of the entire Division.
- 2) Establish processes and provide opportunities for information sharing with the community, engagement of the community, and community input.
- 3) Report Division results at least annually.
- 4) Develop procedures for and to hear appeals as required by statute and/or Board Policy.
- 5) Model a culture that reflects the Board's Code of Conduct.
- 6) Provide for two-way communications between the Board and the school community.
- 7) Commit to the principles of human rights equity and keep this at the forefront of all engagement and decision-making.
