*Thursday, February 29 – withdrawal of noon-hour supervision

- This morning, the STF announced that all Prairie Spirit schools will have a withdrawal of noon-hour supervision on Thursday, February 29, as part of rotating job action.
- Without teachers available to provide supervision over the lunch break, Prairie Spirit
 cannot ensure the safety of students. As a result, all Prairie Spirit students will leave
 the school and school grounds over the lunch break on Thursday.
- Prairie Spirit buses will transport bus students home at the school's determined noon
 dismissal time. Buses cannot accommodate any guest riders or any changes to regular
 route schedules. Transportation will not be provided after the lunch hour or at the end
 of the school day. If your child returns to the school for the afternoon, transportation at
 the end of the school day will be the responsibility of each family, as buses will not run.
- Families may choose to make arrangements for their children over the lunch break with family, friends, or in-town billets. School is open in the afternoon for students who are able to attend, and learning will continue. Your school will confirm the exact schedule

for noon-hour dismissal on Thursday. Because there is no supervision over lunch, it is critical that students do not return to the school until the time provided by your school. School playgrounds will be unsupervised throughout the lunch break and the school doors will be locked.
