Withdrawal of noon-hour supervision – Tuesday, March 5

Prairie Spirit schools will follow a compressed school day with early dismissal in response to the withdrawal of noon-hour supervision on Tuesday, March 5:

- Students will eat during their lunch break at the regular time while teachers provide instruction.
- The school day will be shortened by the length of the teacher duty-free break and students will be dismissed early. Buses will transport students home at that time.
- Teachers will have their duty-free break at the end of the school day.
- On Monday morning, your school will provide an updated school schedule for Tuesday, March 5.
- Specific busing drop-off times will be shared with families on Monday morning.
