French Immersion expanding to high school in Warman

French Immersion programming in Warman will be expanding to include Grade 9 at Warman High School for the 2026/27 school year. The program will continue to grow by a grade each year, eventually offering French Immersion programming for Grades 9 through 12 in 2029/30.

"The Prairie Spirit Board of Education's decision to expand French Immersion programming reflects our commitment to a strong and vibrant bilingual program," said Tracey Young, Director of Education. "Our students will continue to benefit from excellent teaching, resources, and learning opportunities."

The French Immersion program was established in Warman in the fall of 2018. There are currently over 230 French Immersion students in Kindergarten to Grade 7 at École Warman Elementary School. The program will expand to include Grade 8 this fall.

École Warman Elementary School is classified as a dual-track school, offering programming in both English and French.

Prairie Spirit School Division serves 11,500 students in 45 schools and 28 communities surrounding the City of Saskatoon.
