Prairie Spirit School Division is a proud signed partner in the Saskatoon and Area Community Threat Assessment and Support Protocol (CTASP). This protocol allows community partners to proactively share information, advice, and expertise to provide appropriate trauma-informed support to our students and families. Each of our schools has a dedicated team, which includes principals/vice principals, counsellors, and other school leaders, who work within this protocol. Our shared understanding and commitment is to safely equip our staff to effectively intervene and respond when a student is in crisis.

Prairie Spirit School Division has several administrative procedures in place to support our Caring, Healthy, and Safe Schools strategy. Your school principal will be happy to answer any questions you may have.

We look forward to continuing our work with you and our community partners to provide caring, healthy, and safe schools for our students.
