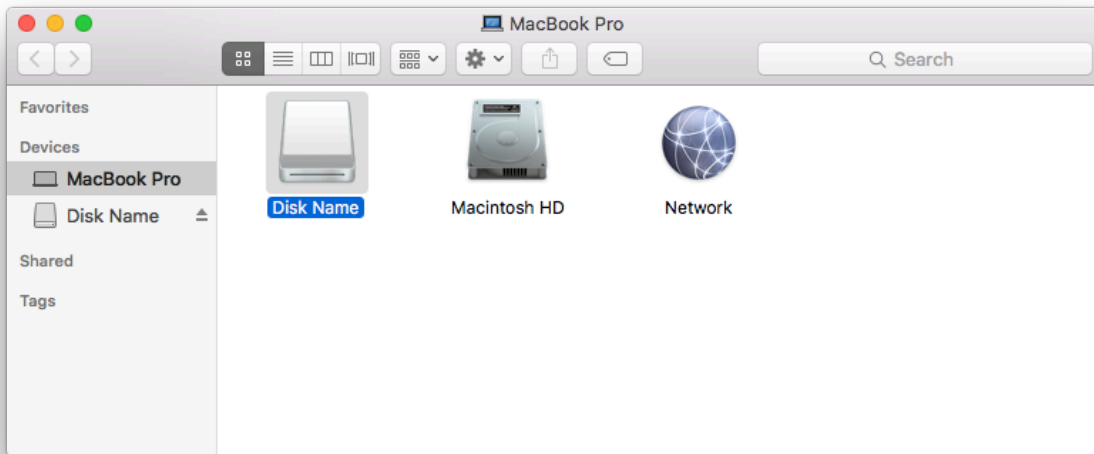


# Encrypting Portable Storage (Mac OS X)

---

1. Plug in your portable device (ex: USB key).
2. Open Finder and browse to your computer under Devices.
3. Right click on the drive you want to encrypt and choose **Encrypt "Disk Name"**.



4. Use a hard to guess password as the encryption key. It is important to remember this password as you will need it to access the data on this device in the future. Click **Encrypt Disk** to continue.



5. When the encryption routine completes, right click on the Disk and select **Eject "Disk Name"**. Wait a few seconds, then remove the device from your computer. You will be prompted to enter your password you used in step 3 to unlock the device in the future.
