Home-Based Education in Prairie Spirit School Division

Home-Based Education is a program that follows the guidelines in Saskatchewan's <u>The Education Act, 1995</u>, and <u>The Home-Based Education Program Regulations, 2015</u>. Parents are responsible for directing, planning, implementing, and assessing a child's education plan in a home-based education program.

Parents living within the boundaries of Prairie Spirit School Division who elect to have their child(ren) as part of the Home-Based Education program must register with Prairie Spirit School Division prior to beginning the program. Registrations should be submitted by September 15th of each school year. Some services and funding are available for home-based educators who enrol in their child(ren) in the program. Parents are also responsible for submitting an education plan at the start of the year and submitting a final progress report in June for each child enrolled in the program.
