## Home-Based Education in Prairie Spirit School Division

Home-Based Education is a program that follows the guidelines in Saskatchewan's [The Education Act, 1995](#), and [The Home-Based Education Program Regulations, 2015](#). **Parents are responsible for directing, planning, implementing, and assessing a child's education plan in a home-based education program.**

Parents living within the boundaries of Prairie Spirit School Division who elect to have their child(ren) as part of the Home-Based Education program must register with Prairie Spirit School Division prior to beginning the program. Registrations should be submitted by September 15<sup>th</sup> of each school year. Some services and funding are available for home-based educators who enrol in their child(ren) in the program. Parents are also responsible for submitting an education plan at the start of the year and submitting a final progress report in June for each child enrolled in the program.
