These academies are integrated into the regular school schedule and provide students with access to high-quality athletic training while maintaining a strong focus on curricular outcomes and academic success.

The academies will run throughout the 2026/27 school year (September to June) at the Rosthern Jubilee Sports Centre and Rosthern Community School.

Flexible Structure – Stay Connected to Your School

Academy students remain fully connected to their home school community. They attend the Academy for the first two hours of the day, where they receive academic credits for their training and learning with high quality instruction from Prairie Spirit teachers. Students then return to regular classes at their home school for the rest of the day. With this model, students maintain relationships with friends and staff at their home school.

This structure supports:

- High-level athletic and academic development for two hours in the morning
- Strong academic engagement for the rest of the school day
- More free time in the evenings for family, friends, work, and other extracurricular activities

Location and Partners

The Rosthern academy will be based out of the Rosthern Jubilee Sports Centre and Rosthern Community School, in collaboration with Trach Sports Academy. The program offers a range of professional partners - mentors, trainers, strength coaches, guest speakers, and community partners. These partnerships ensure students receive expert instruction in athletics, wellness, and leadership, all while staying closely connected to their school community and academic success.

Academics and Curriculum

- Prairie Spirit teachers provide high quality instruction based on the Saskatchewan curriculum
- Student-athletes earn Physical Education and elective credits aligned with the Saskatchewan curriculum
- Programming emphasizes:
 - Skill development and physical literacy
 - Leadership and character education
 - Time management and student accountability
 - Sport-specific and general athletic training
 - Academic achievement and well-being
